Registration and Booking

- If you are interested in your child attending either Early Birds or Night Owls, please complete the registration forms which can be collected from the main school office.
- Once your forms are completed and your child is registered you can then book and pay for your sessions on ParentPay.
- The sessions can only be booked at least 24 hours in advance on ParentPay. If you require an emergency last minute booking you must contact the main school office and we will try our best to accommodate.
